## **Student Progress and Curricular Improvement Academic Year 2010-2011**

### **Students**

In order to preserve confidentiality, the analysis and presentation of the comprehensive exam results for 2010-2011 are omitted in this report, due to the very small number of students taking the exam. Aggregated data will be presented in the five-year report.

### **Curriculum**

The curriculum was fundamentally redesigned in 1998, when the Center for the Study of Early Christianity was established, and again in 2005, when the funding structure was changed. The 1998 curriculum was substantially reviewed when students began to be admitted again in 2007.

The Statement of Goals allows for a curriculum review every five years, and therefore further curricular modifications should be anticipated, if deemed necessary, in 2012.

Rubrics and data-collecting forms have been prepared for use with students entering the program in 2009 and beyond, in accordance with the details contained in the "Goals, and Assessment of Student Outcomes" document.
