Key Assessment Findings

All students in the program of Doctor of Musical Arts in Sacred Music and Ph.D. in Musicology programs passed the comprehensive exam during the AY 2010-2011. In order to preserve confidentiality, the results will not be presented in the report due to the small number of students taking the comps.

All DMA students passed their final recital during the AY 2010-2011. The School of Music began to develop rubrics for all doctoral programs in March 2009. Below is the table of results based on the rubric for the final DMA recital. The sampling is small but does reveal that most students do meet or exceed expectations in the areas assessed. The majority (71%-100%) performed on the level of exceeding expectations in all of the 6 traits.
